A short lived league project was started in the early first half of the 1977/'78 season, to have involved Wembley, Pretoria (Mahem), Durban and Dunswart but the latter promotion pulled out. The Wembley programme of Dec.9th advertised an IPP Lge match, Lions v. Durban Hornets, for Jan.6th but by then the stadium had permanently closed for redevelopment and **only 2 matches are believed to have been staged**

In preparation for a National League in 1982 Buddy Fuller re-constituted the SA. Speedway Control Board at the end of '81. The league was to include East Rand Stars (formerly Dunswart Devils), Durban Hornets, Pretoria Eagles and Tarlton Tomahawks, with a fifth team, Daleside Giants, meeting them in occasional challenge matches. The project went as far as to name teams' make-up, each to include one of the 4 visiting American riders, but **for reasons unknown the competition never materialised.**
